

Presbyterian PREP Scope and Sequence – **Differentiated for Broderick Gillawarna School only**

The Christian SRE class at Broderick Gillawarna School is a music -based version of the Presbyterian Religious Education Program differentiated to suit the needs of the students.

The school is K-12 and students from Stages 1-5 participate these music-based lessons on a rotational basis.

Along with the SRE helper (who has a disability), the SRE teacher has established rapport and the relationship with the school community is maintained. Equity, access and respect are the values displayed in this delivery model.

Lessons consist of

- Teaching songs with appropriate learning activities associated with the concept contained in the music.
- Music making: Students can sing and participate with body percussion or musical instruments.
- SRE teacher leads the students in prayer (non-verbal students can participate by signing “Amen”)

Vol 1 Unit 1: Who is God?

Outcomes: To introduce the God of the bible to & teach some of his major attributes such as love and power

Vol 1 Unit 2: Who is Jesus? (Mark 1-8)

Outcomes: To understand from the gospel of Mark the accounts of Jesus Life and Ministry

- **Who is Jesus?**

Vol 4 Unit 1: The Book of Acts 1-9

Outcomes: To understand the message that 'the early church' was proclaiming in the Book of Acts
