- Live interaction with teachers and other students.
- Online access to all course notes and resources (including an extensive selection of library materials).
- Be part of a like-minded cohort of students from a variety of backgrounds in a caring, supportive environment.

- **Foundational subjects:** Include *Introduction to Preaching*, *Old Testament Overview* and *Christian Belief & Topical Talks*.
- **Text-To-Talk:** Listen to experienced preachers explain how they would teach particular books or sections of the Bible.
- **Teaching Biblical Genres:** Learn principles for teaching different genres, then apply this by giving talks from these genres and receiving feedback.
- **Workshops:** Practical workshops on ministry skills and other topics related to teaching the Bible.
- **Student Talks:** Get plenty of opportunity to give talks on different parts of the Bible and receive quality feedback in a safe and supportive environment.
